

Memorial Hall Overnight Application

Statement of Purpose for Memorial Hall

Memorial Hall exists for the strengthening of the church body, and for the advancement of God's Kingdom through fun, fellowship, and outreach.

RULES

- 1. To reserve any part of Memorial Hall, an application must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the event.**
- 2. Groups using the hall and/or staying in the church facility for overnight use must provide a written notice from their insurance carrier naming Christ Community Church "additionally insured" for the duration of the use.**
- 3. The Administrative Council of the Christ Community Church must approve all requests for use of Memorial Hall and/or the church facility.**
- 4. The use of alcohol, tobacco, profanity, and illegal drugs is prohibited and may be grounds for future refusal for use of Memorial Hall and/or the church facility.**
- 5. The premises must be left in good condition-this is God's house and is to be treated with respect.**
- 6. All sound and projection equipment must be used only by approved church personnel.**

OVERNIGHT STAY FEES

Christ Community Church does not charge a fee for church-related groups using our facility for overnight stays. It is part of our mission outreach to enable groups doing God's work to have a clean, safe environment in which to stay while in transit to or from a mission event, or to provide a place to stay at no cost so that groups may be able to afford admission costs at our local area attractions. If a group chooses to make a donation to our church in appreciation for the use of our facility, it will be thankfully accepted.
